Warnings & Restrictions:

There are no known warnings and restrictions for this product.

Regulations and Compliance:

49 CFR 173.3(c)(1) - If a container of hazardous waste is damaged or leaking, it can be placed in a compatible salvage drum that meets UN criteria for shipping
